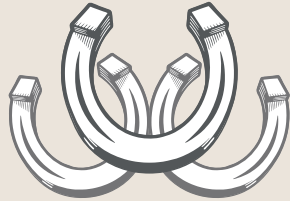

This shows a classic Pinot Noir nose; - leafy, oiled leather, and ripe plums. These all continue onto the palate and finish, which is balanced with slight acidity and velvety soft tannins. Match with Aburi sushi or salmon, grilled vegetables, and poultry.

ABOUT HARPER'S TRAIL

Harper's Trail Estate Winery, named for the cattle drive "trail" of pioneer rancher Thaddeus Harper, is the first winery from Kamloops. Tucked into the city outskirts on the bank of the South Thompson River, Ed and Vicki Collett's vineyard sits among rolling hills of sage and grass, home to Bighorn sheep, bears, and myriad birds. The backdrop of limestone, Hoodoos, and a natural spring set the biodiversity of this rare place. The wines reflect the region, with the minerality and crisp acidity that are becoming known to exemplify the South Thompson area.
